U.S.A./ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

SAT, MAY 7

Depart the U.S.A. today on your overnight transatlantic jet flight, arriving in Rome the following day.

ROME

SUN, MAY 8

Arrive in Rome, the Eternal City. Located in the center of the Region of Lazio, Rome is a reflection of every era. The wonders of Rome surround you... a world of art, history and culture that has been attracting visitors since the beginning of Western civilization. Your first taste of the city will include a visit to the Trevi Fountain and the famous Spanish Steps before continuing to your hotel. **(B,D)**

ROME

MON, MAY 9

Your sightseeing tour this morning takes you to Vatican City and includes visits to the Vatican Museum and Gallery, Raphael's Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's recently restored frescoes and St. Peter's Basilica (please note that visitors wearing shorts or miniskirts are not allowed to enter St. Peter's Basilica). This afternoon visit ancient Rome including the Colosseum, Roman Forum and Arch. **(B,D)**

ROME

TUE, MAY 10

This morning visit the beautifully preserved ruins of Ostia Antica. Founded in the 4th century BC as a military colony to guard the river mouth against seaborne invasions, Ostia later gained prominence as the domestic landing for cargo boats laden with goods for Rome. This afternoon we will meet with the U.S. Commercial Services division at the American Embassy www.buyusa.gov/italy/en. (Please note that electronic devices are not allowed to be brought into the embassy. Please arrange in advance for them to be kept in another location during your visit, otherwise, they will be collected upon arrival and left with the guard). **(B)**

ROME/PARMA/MILAN

WED, MAY 11

This morning travel north to Parma to visit the Dallara Company www.dallara.it before continuing to Milan and our hotel for the night. (B)

MILAN

THU, MAY 12

This morning view Michaelangelo's famous *Last Supper* at the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. Afterwards, your visit of the city will include the Duomo, one of the world's largest, most striking Gothic cathedrals. This afternoon we will visit Monzino 1750 Company www.monzino.it/en. (B)

MILAN/VERONA/VENICE

FRI, MAY 13

After breakfast we will attend a meeting at Deloitte www.deloitte.com. Afterwards, drive to Verona and see the legendary balcony of Juliet. Then continue east to Venice. Built on 118 small islands lying some four kilometers from the mainland, Venetian highways are made of water and the islands are linked by numerous picturesque bridges. Upon arrival in Venice, transfer to your hotel and dinner. (B,D)

VENICE

SAT, MAY 14

Enjoy your morning walking tour of Venice Island beginning at Piazza San Marco. Highlights include the Palace of the Doges, the Bridge of Sighs and the Rialto. You will have the opportunity to enjoy a Gondola ride. Then go on a Glass Tour. The afternoon is at leisure to explore this captivating city on your own. Enjoy dinner at local restaurant. (B,D)

VENICE/MUNICH

SUN, MAY 15

Depart Venice early this morning and head north towards Munich, capital of Bavaria. Munich was ruled for over 650 years by the Wittelsbacher dukes and kings, who left their mark on the architecture and founded the world famous Munich art collection. We will stop enroute for lunch at a local restaurant. This afternoon see Marienplatz, Munich's town square, and view Nymphenburg, the former Royal Residence; Odeon Square with the beautiful Theatiner Church; and the Hall of Generals. (B)

MON, MAY 16

After breakfast we will transfer to our 9:30 AM appointment at Hewlett Packard www.hp.com/uk/hp-information/index.html. This afternoon is reserved for an additional meeting. (B,D)

MUNICH

TUE, MAY 17

This morning visit the Max Planck Institute www.max-planck-innovation.de/en. This afternoon visit Dachau concentration camp, a sobering reminder of Hitler's Third Reich. Return to Munich and your hotel and enjoy dinner at local restaurant. (B,D)

All too soon your trip is over as you board your flight back to the U.S.A., arriving the same day. (B)
